Home School Agreement

The School will:

- Share with parents the school's vision and aims.
- Provide a broad, balanced, rich and creative curriculum in and out of school.
- Value all children as individuals.
- Strive to ensure all children achieves his/her potential.
- Keep children safe at school and teach them how to be safe out of school, including online.
- Encourage the highest of expectations of learning and behaviour.
- Keep parents informed on the progress their child is making and their behaviour and wellbeing.
- Keep parents informed about school activities and general school matters through regular letters home, newsletters and other forms of communication.
- Be open and welcoming to parents and encourage them to become actively involved in the life of the school.
- Contact parents if there is a problem with work, behaviour, wellbeing, attendance or punctuality.

Parents/Guardians will:

- Support the school's vision, values, policies and behaviour expectations.
- Contact the school to discuss any matters that might affect their child's progress, wellbeing or behaviour.
- Ensure that their child attends school regularly, on time and properly dressed in school uniform.
- Notify the school promptly when the child is absent.
- Only remove their child from school for appointments, sickness and in exceptional circumstances.
- Support their child with regular reading and home learning.
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about their child's progress, wellbeing and behaviour.
- Get to know about their child's life at school.
- Actively look to be part of the school community.
- Respect all members of the school community.
- Support the school's approach to online safety.
- Ensure children only have access to age-appropriate games and social media apps.

Children will:

- Come to school regularly and on time.
- Show a positive attitude to learning, doing their best in work and play.
- Wear smart school uniform.
- Model the school values.
- Be kind to others.
- Take good care of the school equipment and environment.
- Read regularly at home and complete home learning on time.
- Treat everyone with respect and follow classroom and playground rules.
- Be an active part of the school community.
- Tell an adult if they need support with their learning, behaviour or feelings.
